### What is Homeopathy?

Homeopathy is a scientific medical system which encourages the body to heal itself. Symptoms of ill health are pattern matched with a homeopathic remedy to restore energy balance. Homeopathy is not herbalism and is not a cure-all.

### How can homeopathy help?

Homeopathic medicines support anxiety, insomnia, asthma, eczema, psoriasis, ENT, migraines, PMS, menopausal problems, IBS. Dental problems such as mouth ulcers, dental abscess, dry socket, periodontal disease and toothache benefit from homeopathic remedies very often when conventional medicines have stopped working.

### Is homeopathy safe?

Yes - providing the homeopathic remedy is properly prescribed and taken as instructed. Homeopathic medicines can be used in pregnancy, for babies and young children.

The elderly also benefit because homeopathic medicines can be integrated with conventional drug regimes.

### What does a homeopath need to know?

A detailed medical and family history plus details of your complaint and how it affects your lifestyle. An integrated approach using both conventional and complementary medicine is encouraged.

### What does homeopathic treatment involve?

Remedies are usually prescribed in liquid drops, tablets, lozenges or powder form to be taken orally. Oral/written instructions will be given with the prescription. You stop taking the medicine when you feel better.

### Do I need to tell my GP?

Please discuss your treatment with your GP if you think it appropriate. Permission to contact your GP will be sought if required. I may recommend routine tests via your GP. All data is confidential.

### How do I keep homeopathic medicines?

Please keep your medicines dry, cool and in a safe place away from young children. Make sure that remedies are well away from mobile phones, microwave and TV radiation. Keep the medicines away from herbal and aromatic oils.
